Recipe Swap

HAM BUNS

½ c. butter or margarine
1 small onion, grated
1 T. poppy seed
2 tsp. Worcestershire sauce
2 tsp. prepared mustard
1-1/4 c. finely chopped fully cooked ham
1 c. shredded swiss cheese
16 to 20 mini buns or 6-8 hamburger buns

In a bowl, mix butter, onion, poppy seed, worcestershire sauce and mustard until well blended. Add ham and cheese, mix well. Divide evenly among buns. Place in a shallow baking pan and cover with foil. Bake at 350* for 15-20 minutes or until hot.

CHOCOLATE CHIP CHEESE BALL

8 oz. cream cheese
½ c. butter, no substitutes
¼ tsp. vanilla
¾ c. powdered sugar
2 T. brown sugar
¾ c. mini semisweet chocolate chips
¾ c. chopped pecans

Beat cream cheese, butter and vanilla in a mixing bowl until fluffy. Add sugars and combine. Stir in chocolate chips by hand. Cover and refrigerate for 2 hours. Place in plastic wrap and shape into a ball. Refrigerate for another hour. Before serving roll in chopped pecans. Serve with graham crackers and vanilla wafers.

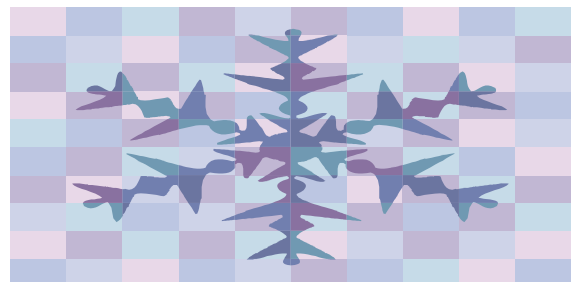
BIBLE STUDY: The adult bible study will meet this Wednesday. The ladies bible study will not meet until Jan. 4th.


