
DON'T FORGET THE SOCKS AND BRIEFS!!!

Recipe Swap

GRAPE SALAD

2 lbs. green grapes

2 lbs. red grapes

8 oz. sour cream

8 oz. cream cheese (room temperature)

½ c. sugar

1 tsp. vanilla extract

Wash and stem grapes and set aside. Mix sour cream, cream cheese, sugar and vanilla by hand until blended. Stir grapes into mixture and pour into a large serving bowl.

Topping: 1 c, brown sugar, to taste 1c. crushed pecans, to taste

Combine brown sugar and crushed pecans. Sprinkle over top of grapes to cover completely. Chill overnight.
