Many years ago there was a series of television shows called 'In Search of...' The weekly show would try to research and find paranormal or controversial subjects and present them to the television audience in a documentary format. The list of things 'searched for' included the Titanic, UFOs, Bigfoot and the Loch Ness Monster.

A couple of weeks ago, the Kirby family set out on our own 'In Search of." In search of...the eagle's nest. We read about the eagles nesting at Banner Creek Reservoir west of Holton and wanted to see for ourselves. We had never witnessed live eagles nesting or baby eagles in the wild, so we embarked on our adventure.

The first thing that happened is that we got distracted by garage sales. We had no idea that Holton's city wide garage sales were going on the same weekend. After 'garage sale-ing' and grabbing a bite to eat, we headed toward the lake. We stopped at one more garage sale we found near the lake. While there, I asked them about the location of the nest. They gave me information that I thought I followed, but it didn't lead to the eagles. At first I thought they had given me bad directions, but in retrospect, I think I just misunderstood the directions (like that has NEVER happened before!).

So we kept searching. We drove around the lake following the map we found on my phone. Gravel roads took us close to the lake, but not right up to it. Finally, we were on the other side of the lake and crested a hill on the dirt road. There was a very good view of the west end of the lake and finally, we saw a clump that might have been a nest in the top of a dead tree. A look through the binoculars confirmed that it was indeed an eagle's nest, though I wasn't sure if I could see an eagle or not.

I did remember seeing a hiking trail a little ways back. Maybe, just maybe...We turned around and drove back down to the bottom of the hill, parked and walked the trail. The trail was straight, not real wide, and was less than 100 yards to the lakeshore.

Once there, the horizon opened up. There were lots of dead trees sticking up out of the water, a few ducks and maybe a heron. As we looked out in the distance, there it was! The nest was wedged in the tree branches with two adult eagles sitting on it with their young. It still was a long ways off, but the binoculars brought it in closer. Sometimes you could see one adult, other times, two. It was more difficult to see the babies, but we were able to make them out. It was amazing. In search of the eagle's nest...found!

Another great 'In Search of' that this excursion reminds me of is the search for God (or for meaning, because you won't find meaning without God).

In this search, it is easy to get distracted. We let our worries, the world and all the bright, shiny things that draw our attention distract us from what really matters. Satan would be really happy if we never found God because we were just so distracted by everything he throws our way.

Our search for God is sometimes sabotaged by bad information. People give us unbiblical advice, try to get us to accept worldly theories or push false religions upon us. Other times, we get good information, but we aren't listening closely or we interpret that information based upon what we want to hear more than what is actually said.

Although people searching for Bigfoot, Nessie or UFOs have come up empty, we found the eagles. The bible tells us if we search for God with all our hearts, we will find Him (Dt 4:29). The path taking us to where we could see the eagle's nest was straight and narrow and we were the only ones there during this time. *Matthew 7:14* (*NIV*) ¹⁴ But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.

Finally, we gained clarity as the binoculars brought everything closer and into focus. If we look at the world and life through the lens of the scriptures, it will bring everything into focus and bring God so much nearer.

Keep searching the truths of God from the scriptures. Keep studying His word. You will find peace, hope, joy and love. You will find the key to life for this world and the next.

Recipe Swap

VANILLA CREAM FRUIT TART

3/4 c. butter or margarine, softened

½ c. powdered sugar

1-1/2 c. flour

10 oz. vanilla chips, melted and cooled

½ c. whipping cream

8 oz. cream cheese

1 pint fresh strawberries, sliced

1 c. fresh blueberries

1 c. fresh raspberries

½ c. pineapple juice

¼ c. sugar

1 T. cornstarch

½ t. lemon juice

In a mixing bowl, cream butter and powdered sugar. Beat in flour (mixture will be crumbly). Pat into the bottom of a greased 12-in. pizza pan. Bake at 300* for 25-28 minutes or until lightly browned. Cool. In another mixing bowl, beat melted chips and whipping cream. Add cream cheese; beat until smooth. Spread over crust. Chill for 30 minutes. Arrange berries over filling. In a saucepan, combine pineapple juice, sugar, cornstarch and lemon juice; bring to a boil over medium heat. Boil for 2 minutes or until thickened. stirring constantly. Cool; brush over fruit. Chill 1 hour before serving. Store in the refrigerator.
