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#### **Recipe Swap**

#### DOUBLE LEMON CHEESECAKE BARS

2 c. vanilla wafer crumbs

3 T. melted butter

4 pkg. (8 oz. each) cream cheese, softened

1 3/4 c. sugar, divided

3 T. flour

1 T. lemon zest

1/3 c. lemon juice, divided

½ tsp. vanilla

4 eggs, 1 separated

2 T. cornstarch

½ c. water

Heat oven to 325\* and line a 13x9 inch pan with foil. Mix wafer crumbs and butter; press onto bottom of pan. Bake 10 minutes. Beat cream cheese, 1 cup sugar, flour, lemon zest, 2 T. lemon juice, and vanilla with mixer until blended. Add 1 egg white and remaining 3 whole eggs, beating after each just until blended. (Reserve volk for later use.) Pour batter over crust. Bake 40 minutes or until center is almost set. Cool 1 hour. Refrigerate 4 hours. Mix cornstarch and remaining sugar in saucepan; gradually stir in water and remaining lemon juice. Bring just to a boil, stirring constantly; cook and stir until clear and thickened. Lightly beat reserved egg yolk until blended; stir in 2 T. hot cornstarch mixture. Return to remaining cornstarch mixture in saucepan; cook and stir 1 minute or until thickened, Cool, Spoon glaze over cheesecake. Refrigerate 1 hour. Use foil to remove cheesecake from pan before cutting to serve.
