Saturday, July 26th, God blessed the free school supply project with 45 volunteers from different churches, organizations and businesses to reflect His love to meet the needs of others. The fruits of the spirit were in everyone as they worked side by side to meet the needs of many thankful families. Thanks to all of you who helped in anyway through prayer, giving of your time, monetary gifts, donating supplies and clothing, hauling supplies and for the food and anything we forgot to mention!!!! Set up on Friday night was possible with 28 volunteers arriving to sort and set up supplies. Then on Saturday morning we discovered that families started arriving as early as 5:00 AM! The door was open at 8:00 AM until 11:00 AM and there were 326 students that came to pick up supplies. Families are still making request for supplies, making our total over 350 students.

Some of the Bible translations we read have headings over sections of scripture. These headings aren't scripture, but are the translators' efforts to summarize the section you are about to read. I noticed in reading Romans 12 beginning with verse 9 that my translation of choice, the English Standard Version, has the heading, 'Marks of a True Christian.' Over the course of several newsletters, I will focus on some of these 'marks' to try to encourage our body to 'walk the walk,' that is, live out our faith in real and practical ways.

The Bible makes it clear that there should be evidence, or fruit, in the life of a Christian. The person who claims to be a Christian and then does nothing to live the Christian life except agree to say they believe in Jesus should reexamine themselves to see if they are truly in the faith. As James writes, "faith without works is a dead faith."

There are other scriptures that spell out what a believer should act like, but I will focus on Romans 12:9-13.

Romans 12:9-13 (ESV) ⁹ Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good. ¹⁰ Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor. ¹¹ Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the Lord. ¹² Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer. ¹³ Contribute to the needs of the saints and seek to show hospitality.

Because of some current needs, I will address verse 11 this month. *Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the Lord.* The NLT phrases that verse, *"Never be lazy, but work hard and serve the Lord enthusiastically."*

How do we serve the Lord? Does He really need anything from us? Some people have the idea that they don't need to do anything for the church. "If God wants it done, then it'll get done" seems to be their mantra. First let's be clear. The church is vital. The Bible says Christ died for the church (Eph 5:25). Jesus said "I will build my church (whose church? Jesus' church!) and the gates of hell will not prevail upon it." (Matt 16:18) The church is God's plan, God's invention, designed <u>by Him</u> to bring believers together as a community to be the body of Christ on earth. Say what you want about the church: 'It's boring, it's not relevant, they don't need me, it's full of hypocrites, it doesn't meet my needs (by the way, the church is designed for YOU to meet the needs of others – that is service)' the one thing you <u>can't</u> get from the scriptures is that you get a free pass and don't need to be involved in the church (Heb 10:25).

The church is the community/family where we are to do life together. We encourage, pray, worship – and serve. Wherever this community comes together, that is church. Within the church, we serve. When we serve in the church, we all then become equipped to serve Christ in the world.

The church always needs workers. Greeters, servers, readers, teachers, people to visit others, prayer warriors, youth leaders, nursery workers - the list goes on and on. Some work is visible to others, some is behind the scenes. So let us not be lax in our church attendance or in our work within the church. It does not please the Lord when we are.

And when we serve, we are to serve enthusiastically. When we serve, but act like we would rather do anything else, does that please the Lord? When we seem disappointed that someone asked us to help with something, does that encourage others? Let's serve with zeal, with enthusiasm! "Yes, I'd be glad to help," sounds so much better than "Yeah, I guess so, if I have to." Oh, and we usually don't say the 'if I have to' part, but it is often obvious by our expressions.

We can take it one step further in our enthusiasm. What if people were so enthusiastic about serving within the church community that we didn't wait for someone to ask us to do something? What if we saw a need, asked the leadership if we could do something about meeting that need, then actually did it? And if the leaders of the church had specific guidelines about how to do something, we accepted that gracefully and submitted to the authority that God has put into place?

Recipe Swap MEXICAN CASSEROLE

1 lb. hamburger
1 medium onion, chopped
1 can corn, drained
1 can black beans, drained and rinsed
1 pkg. taco mix
8-12 corn tortillas
³/₄ c. sour cream
2 cans rotel, drained
1/3 c. Mexican blend shredded cheese
Sliced jalapenos, opt.

Cook hamburger and onions till meat is done, drain. Add corn, beans, rotel and taco mix. Spray a 2 qt. 8x12 dish with cooking spray. Place half of the tortillas then half of the meat mixture. Then place all of the sour cream on next. Repeat with tortillas and meat mixture. Place in heated 350* oven for 25 minutes. Remove from heat and top with cheese and jalapenos. Cook for 5 more minutes or until cheese is melted. Let stand for 5 more minutes then serve.
