Word of the Month: Life

Think about all the things today's culture says make up a good life.

Wealth. Oh, to be a one-percenter. What a great life to be able to eat in the finest restaurants and turn around and hire a personal trainer to help you work it off in your own personal gym. You would be able to fly first class, or if you are rich enough, buy your own jet. You could vacation as often as you like in the most exotic locales. If I just had money, I would have an amazing life.

Howard Hughes was at one time the wealthiest man in the world. He had a great life...except for the fact that he was a miserable recluse and a drug addict that died alone.

If I could just win that \$500 million Powerball lottery! Except the many of the people who win multi-million dollar lotteries manage to ruin relationships, end up on drugs or do something else illegal, all while squandering all of the money.

Wealth can make life easier, but it is no guarantee of a good life. It often brings on more problems than it solves. *1 Timothy 6:9* But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation, into a snare, into many senseless and harmful desires that plunge people into ruin and destruction.

If I only had a perfect marriage, then my life would be good! If my spouse were younger, better looking, more intimate or more loving, then my life would be complete. Look how well that has worked out. The divorce rate is hovering somewhere north of 40%, maybe even 50%. People who divorce and remarry have even a higher rate of divorce. It seems that trying to base your happiness for life in a marriage partner doesn't work very well. That might be because people are selfish, make too many demands and have too many expectations from a spouse. Your husband or wife is a person marred by a sin nature. No matter how hard they try, they will let you down and you will let them down.

Whatever you think our world offers that will give you a complete life, it won't. Fame, power, good looks - nothing guarantees an abundant life. To top that off, what happens when you breathe your last breath? Your body rots (no more good looks), you can't take your wealth with you and someone else gets your corner office. Then what do you have?

Luke 12:15; 29-31 And he said to them, "Take care, and be on your guard against all

covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." And do not seek what you are to eat and what you are to drink, nor be worried. For all the nations of the world seek after these things, and your Father knows that you need them. Instead, seek his kingdom, and these things will be added to you.

Life is much more than what this world offers. This life, from birth to death, is only a speck compared to true life, eternal life. All the wealth, fame, power or happiness can't buy this eternal life, this true life. Yet even Christians get caught up in trying to find fulfillment in life through our family or other relationships, our jobs or our possessions. That's not life.

Here is how Jesus defines life. It isn't overly difficult or philosophical. It is quite simple. *John 17:3* And this is eternal life, that they know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent.

That's it. Know the One True God and Jesus. Not know of their reputation. Not have head knowledge about them. Know them. Have a real relationship with the Triune God-Father, Son and Spirit.

Jesus is life. He is the source and sustainer of life. He is the giver of life and he has purchased eternal life for each one of us if we will just receive him for our salvation. If you really want to get to know Jesus, read the book of John. Here is what the fourth gospel says about Jesus and life.

John 1:4 In him (Jesus) was life, and the life was the light of men. John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. John 3:36 Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him. John 5:24 Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life. John 8:12 Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." John 10:10 The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly. John 11:25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Recipe Swap

FESTIVE HAM GLAZE

1 bone-in fully cooked ham (5 to 8 pounds)

1-1/2 cups orange juice

1-1/4 cups packed brown sugar

1 T. grated orange peel

1 tsp. dry mustard

1/4 tsp. ground cloves

Score surface of ham, making diamond shapes ½ inch deep. Place in a large baking dish. In a bowl, mix remaining ingredients; pour over ham. Cover and refrigerate overnight, turning ham occasionally. Reserving glaze, remove ham to a rack in a shallow roasting pan. Insert meat thermometer. Bake, uncovered at 325* until thermometer registers 140*, about 2-4 hours, brushing occasionally with glaze. Yield: 10-16 servings.
