These are just a few of the items that students will need:



O thus be it ever,

When free men shall stand Between their loved homes And the war's desolation; Blest with vict'ry and peace, May the heav'n rescued land Praise the Pow'r that hath made And preserved us a nation! And the star-spangled banner In triumph shall wave O'er the land of the free And the home of the brave. ~Francis Scott Key

Thus reads the **second** verse of our National Anthem, The Star-Spangled Banner. Most people don't realize there is a second verse, let alone that the second verse credits the establishment of our nation, and by extension our freedom in this nation, to the power of God.

Yet I believe we are slowly losing freedoms in the United States. The First Amendment of the Constitution states, "Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech..."

Recent cases have shown us that certain flower shop owners, bakeries and wedding venues are not allowed the freedom to exercise their faith as they see fit. Their deeply held religious beliefs forbid them to provide services to gay weddings because they believe marriage is only for one man and one woman as ordained by God in the scriptures. Yet they have been fined, bullied and threatened with financial ruin – by the government!

By the time this is printed, the Supreme Court may have already ruled on same-sex marriage. They could rule that the issue is to be left up to the states. That is, each state can individually endorse or ban same-sex marriage in their laws or constitutions. Or, they might rule that state bans on homosexual marriage violate the U.S. Constitution, thus making it legal in all fifty states. If it becomes legal across this nation, you can expect to see persecution against those who refuse to comply.

On campus after campus across this nation, the concept of free speech is a joke. Uttering words – or even making social media comments – that violate a university's accepted 'speech code' could get you expelled.

What are we to do? I believe we can stand up for our freedom in this nation. We do what we can to turn the tide in congress, the oval office, state and local governments and even in the schools and universities. Vote, be involved in the process and write (email) your elected officials – often. If push comes to shove, we obey God rather than men (Acts 5:29).

Second, we need to realize that nowhere does the Bible guarantee the Christian gets to live in a free country. Christianity began and flourished in a Roman dictatorship. Throughout history, the more the church was persecuted, the stronger she grew.

Third, let's be aware that there are people living in this nation who are oppressed and in slavery, while those living in communist or Islamic nations experience true freedom.

The true freedom I speak of is our freedom in Christ. There are many who live in our free nation, yet are overwhelmed by the chains of worry, anxiety and fear. Others are slaves to their own selfishness and sin, with no relief in sight. They are slaves because they do not have Jesus as their savior.

True Christians living in communist China or North Korea or in Islamic nations like Sudan, Saudi Arabia or Egypt have no rights, but they experience true freedom from the burden of their sin and know they have a home of eternal freedom waiting for them when this life ends.

Recipe Swap COOL CUCUMBER SALAD

medium cucumber, quartered and sliced
medium tomato, chopped
c. chopped green pepper
1/3 c. chopped sweet onion
T. lime juice
T. red wine vinegar or cider vinegar
4 tsp. dill weed
tsp. salt
tsp. pepper

In a large bowl, combine the cucumber, tomato, green pepper and onion. In a small bowl, combine lime juice, vinegar, dill, salt and pepper. Pour over cucumber mixture; toss to coat. Cover and refrigerate for 15 minutes. Serve with a slotted spoon. Yield: 4 servings

Galatians 5:1 (ESV) For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.
