#### The Word of the Month: Grace

"You don't have to do that!"

Have you ever heard those words when you wanted to help someone? Or did you utter them when someone tried to help you? We often use that phrase because the one who is trying to do something for us truly doesn't need to. They don't owe us anything. Whatever it is they want to do would be over and above what one might expect. If that has happened to you, you have probably experience grace from another person.

Gina and I have some dear friends from the Leavenworth area. When Gina's mom died, they just kind of swooped in and took over. They arranged a dinner after the funeral for the family, paid for it and made sure we were taken care of by the time everyone finally left. They didn't have to do that. We had never done anything like that for them. They had no obligation to serve us that day, or any day.

They did it because they love us and they wanted to show us God's grace working through their hands.

Grace is unmerited, unearned favor. A Christian can remember the meaning of grace with this simple acronym:

God's Riches At Christ's Expense

What really makes the acronym work, however, is when we realize that it isn't merely that we don't deserve God's riches, but that we were enemies of God, wretched and blind, when he gave that grace. So we deserve death and hell, yet God makes available to us forgiveness and heaven and eternal life. He gives that by his grace.

God has given all mankind a common grace. Even unbelievers enjoy the next breath even though they deserve death.

The rain waters the ground of the saved as well as the unsaved. It is this common grace that God has given us that leaves the unbeliever without excuse when they reject Christ. **Romans 1:20 (ESV)** <sup>20</sup> For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse.

In order to be born again, we must receive Christ as our Lord and Savior. That is how we lay hold of his sacrifice. That is the "Christ's Expense" part of the acronym. Jesus died on the cross and shed his blood as a payment for our sin debt. He takes our sin upon Himself and we have his righteousness credited to our account. **Ephesians 2:8-9 (ESV)** 8 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, 9 not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

God also gives us grace in order to serve him. *Romans 12:6 (NLT)* <sup>6</sup> *In his grace, God has given us different gifts for doing certain things well* ... Spiritual gifts are given to every believer to use to serve God and each other. We can't do anything to earn them; we don't deserve them. God gives them to us because he loves us.

God gives us grace to endure trials. Paul prayed often for God to remove some affliction he was dealing with. **2 Corinthians 12:9 (ESV)** <sup>9</sup> But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

God will give us the grace we need to get through anything he allows. We must access that grace through prayer and faith.

Finally, we are to show grace to others. **2 Corinthians 8:7 (ESV)** <sup>7</sup> But as you excel in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all earnestness, and in our love for you—see that you excel in this act of grace also.

# RECIPE SWAP Cookie Cheesecake Pizza

1 roll of sugar cookie dough 1 small package of cheesecake pudding mix 1-1/2 c. milk Pie filling of your choice

Cut the sugar cookie roll into slices. Lay them on a 12 inch round pizza pan. Press with your hands until there is no space between slices and it forms a crust. Bake at 350\* for 15-20 minutes or until done. Let cool. Mix pudding mix with milk and let set in refrigerator until set. Spread on cooled crust. Put in the refrigerator. When ready to serve top with pie filling.

**2 Corinthians 8:9 (ESV)** <sup>9</sup> For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you by his poverty might become rich.

And now I conclude this note with the words Paul used to close his second letter to the Corinthian church. **2 Corinthians 13:14** (ESV) <sup>14</sup> The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.
