MOM'S EMPTY CHAIR

A woman's daughter had asked the local minister to come and pray with her mother.

When the minister arrived, he found the woman lying in bed with her head propped up on two pillows.

The minister assumed that the woman had been informed of his visit. "I guess you were expecting me", he said.

"No, who are you?" said the mother.

"I have never told anyone this, not even my daughter," said the woman. "But all of my life I have never known how to pray. At church I used to hear the pastor talk about prayer, but it went right over my head."

"I abandoned any attempt at prayer," the old woman continued, "until one day four years ago, my best friend said to me," "prayer is just a simple matter of having a conversation with Jesus. Here is what I suggest. Sit down in a chair; place an empty chair in front of you, and in faith see Jesus on the chair. It's not spooky because He promised "I will be with you always"

"Then just speak to Him in the same way you're doing with me right now."

But there was something strange about her death. Apparently, just before mom died, she leaned over and rested her head on the chair beside the bed. What do you make of that?"

The minister wiped a tear from his eye and said "I wish we could all go like that."

What if It Was Me?

I sometimes think about the 'players' in the Christmas account. Some of them we know by name, others aren't even mentioned. What if I put myself in their shoes? How would I react? Would we still have the same story?

What if it was me? What if I was Mary's father?

"Where is that Joseph? I'll chase him down and have him stoned for what he did to my little girl!" "And where **is** Mary anyway? She's no daughter of mine!

What if it was me? What if I was Mary's mother?

"Honey, I thought we raised you better than that. Now look at what you've donegone and ruined your life. No respectable man will marry you now. I don't want to hear that lie about the Son of God any more, either!"

What if it was me? What if I was Joseph?

"Another man? How could you? I loved you and now you have betrayed me! I never want to see you again! You know I could have you stoned, right?"
Even after Joseph was visited by an angel confirming Mary's testimony that the child was of the Holy Spirit, how would I react? "How do I explain this to others? Who will believe the child is of the Holy Spirit? I will get blamed. I'll lose business. I will have to endure the scorn of the entire community. Sorry God, this is too hard. Find someone else."

What if it was me? What if I was Mary? "Why me, God? I can't do this. My mother and father will disown me. Joseph will hate me. I'll be an outcast to everyone in town. I don't want to. Find someone else. I won't do it! I can't do it. I'm not strong enough."

What if it was me? What if I was Jesus?

"Wait, what? I leave heaven and become human? For real? As a baby? Then I don't even get to marry or have children and have to die on a cross? Uh, I don't think so, Dad."

What if it was me? What if I was God? "Send my Son for...THOSE people? Why should I? They are murderers and adulterers and He has never done anything wrong. He doesn't deserve to die, they do!"

It is a good thing I'm not Joseph. When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife. **Matt 1:24**

It is a good thing I'm not Mary. And Mary said: "My soul glorifies the Lord and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, for he has been mindful of the humble state of his servant. From now on all generations will call me blessed, for the Mighty One has done great things for me-- holy is his name. Luke 1:46-49

It is a good thing I'm not Jesus. Recipe Swap

SWEET POTATO CASSEROLE

3 c. mashed sweet potatoes

½ c. sugar

½ tsp. salt

½ stick butter

2 eggs

½ c. evaporated milk

2 tsp. vanilla

Mix all of the above together and put in a lightly greased casserole dish.

TOPPING:

½ stick butter

3/4 c. brown sugar

1 c. chopped pecans

1/3 c. flour

Blend butter, brown sugar and flour together with a fork or a pastry blender. Add chopped pecans and cover the sweet potato mixture with the pecan mixture. Bake at 350* for 30 minutes or until hot through.
