
Please place supplies in the blue container in the foyer. If you would like to make a monetary donation instead there will be a container available in the foyer.

Recipe Swap

SIMPLE S'MORES CAKE

1 package milk chocolate cake mix

- 1 small package instant chocolate pudding 1 ½ c. milk
- 10 oz. mini marshmallows
- 1 c. milk chocolate chips

5 whole graham crackers, broken into bite sized pieces

Preheat oven to 350*. Spray a 13x9 inch baking pan with nonstick cooking spray. Combine cake mix, pudding mix and milk in large bowl; beat 1 to 2 minutes or until well blended. Spread batter in prepared pan. Bake 30-35 minutes or until toothpick inserted into center comes out clean. Turn oven to broil. Sprinkle marshmallows, chocolate chips and graham crackers over cake. Broil 6 inches from heat source 30 seconds to 1 minute or until marshmallows are golden brown. Cool at least 15 minutes before serving.
