THE BUZZARD

If you put a buzzard in a pen that is 6 feet by 8 feet and is entirely open at the top, the bird, in spite of its ability to fly, will be an absolute prisoner. The reason is that a buzzard always begins a flight from the ground with a run of 10-12 feet. Without space to run, as is its habit, it will not even attempt to fly, but will remain a prisoner for life in a small jail with no top.

Recipe Swap

PUMPKIN PECAN COBBLER

1 c. + 3 T. flour

2 tsp. baking powder

½ tsp. salt

34 c. sugar

1 tsp. cinnamon

½ tsp. nutmeg

¼ tsp. cloves

½ c. pumpkin puree

¼ c. milk

1/4 c. melted butter or oil

1 ½ tsp. vanilla

Topping:

½ c. sugar

½ c. brown sugar

1/4 c. chopped pecans

1 ½ c. very hot water

Preheat oven to 350*. In a medium sized bowl, stir together flour, baking powder, salt, sugar and spices. Set aside.

In a smaller bowl, stir pumpkin, milk, melted butter and vanilla together to combine. Pour into dry ingredients and mix to create a thick batter. Pour into a small 8 inch casserole dish with high sides.

In a separate bowl, stir sugar, brown sugar and pecans together. Spread over the top of the batter evenly. Pour hot water over the entire thing {WITHOUT STIRRING A THING!} and bake for 40 minutes or once the middle is set. Be sure to place on a baking sheet in case it bubbles over. Cool 5-10 minutes before serving. Serve with more pecans and vanilla ice cream. Makes 8 servings.
