JAMs

School will be starting soon, which means its time for JAMs to gear up too! Jesus and Me, or JAMs for short, is our after school children's ministry program. It's open to kids in Kindergarten – 6th grade, and is held every Wednesday. Last year was the first year of JAMs after several years without an after school program. After feeling the need through the Holy Spirit to start this ministry back up, and a great deal of prayer, JAMs came to life in an amazing way! Our first session started with over 30 kids, and quickly showed us that this ministry truly was needed, that we shouldn't have doubted that God would bring lots of kids (we thought we would have maybe 12-15 at most), and that we needed more volunteers to help! We ended up with a total of 47children enrolled, and had an amazing weekly staff of 6 adults and 4 youth group helpers. Each session is similar to VBS with prayer, songs, snack, games/crafts, and a lesson.

Why is children's ministry such a big deal? An estimated 50% of Christians decided to follow Christ before they were 12 years old...that's our K-6th graders!

In Mark 10:14, Jesus says "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these." Children are precious to Jesus, and our JAMs kids are at a prime age to learn that they are loved, that they need a Savior, and to trust in Him for the rest of their lives!

We are very excited to kick off JAMs this year, starting September 6, from 3:30-5:00 PM. We need helpers! Areas you can serve in are picking up/walking with the kids from school, walking leaders (we need 2), snack servers, music, or games/crafts. Be prayerful, and if you would like to help out, let Erin Thomas or Tiffany Spencer know!

Community

I was struck by a recent devotion from Our Daily Bread. Hopefully, many of you have already read it, but I believe it warrants another look. It simply speaks of the need we have to be in a Christ-centered community that we call the church. Here is the devotion, reprinted with permission, in its entirety.

Building Community By: Philip Yancey

This mystery is that through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs together with Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise in Christ Jesus. Ephesians 3:6

"Community" is the place where the person you least want to live with always lives, says Henri Nouwen.

Often we surround ourselves with the people we *most* want to live with, which forms a club or a clique, not a community. Anyone can form a club; it takes grace, shared vision, and hard work to form a community.

The Christian church was the first institution in history to bring together on equal footing Jews and Gentiles, men and women, slaves and free. The apostle Paul waxed eloquent on this "mystery, which for ages past was kept hidden in God." By forming a community out of diverse members, Paul said, we have the opportunity to capture the attention of the world and even the supernatural world beyond (Eph. 3:9–10).

In some ways the church has sadly failed in this assignment. Still, church is the one place I visit that brings together generations: infants still held in their mothers' arms, children who squirm and giggle at all the wrong times, responsible adults who know how to act appropriately at all times,

and those who may drift asleep if the preacher drones on too long.

If we want the community experience God is offering to us, we have reason to seek a congregation of people "not like us."

Lord, remind us that the church is Your work, and You have brought us together for Your good purposes. Help us extend grace to others.

The devotion included this scripture passage to read:

Ephesians 2:19 – 3:11 So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit.

For this reason I, Paul, a prisoner of Christ Jesus on behalf of you Gentiles assuming that you have heard of the stewardship of God's grace that was given to me for you, how the mystery was made known to me by revelation, as I have written briefly. When you read this, you can perceive my insight into the mystery of Christ, which was not made known to the sons of men in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit. This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel.

Recipe Swap

Cheese Ball Dip

- 1 Package real bacon pieces
- 4 cups grated cheese
- 1 cup mayo
- Pepper to taste

Combine all ingredients. Add more cheese and mayo until you reach desired texture.

Buffalo Chicken Dip

- 2 cups ranch or blue cheese dressing

America's Christian Heritage:

I have lived, Sir, a long time and the longer I live, the more convincing proofs I see of this truth -- that **God** governs in the affairs of men. And if a sparrow cannot fall to the ground without his notice, is it probable that an empire can rise without his aid? We have been assured, Sir, in the sacred writings that "except the Lord build they labor in vain that build it." I firmly believe this; and I also believe that without his concurring aid we shall succeed in this political building no better than the Builders of Babel: We shall be divided by our little partial local interests; our projects will be confounded, and we ourselves shall be become a reproach and a bye word down to future age. And what is worse, mankind may hereafter this unfortunate instance, despair of establishing Governments by Human Wisdom, and leave it to chance, war, and conquest.

I therefore beg leave to move -- that henceforth prayers imploring the assistance of Heaven, and its blessings on our deliberations, be held in this Assembly every morning before we proceed to business, and that one or more of the Clergy of this City be requested to officiate in that service.
