Recipe Swap

SLOW COOKER CHICKEN ENCHILADA SOUP

2 large chicken breasts, raw
1 10 oz. can red enchilada sauce
1 14 oz. can black beans, drained and rinsed
1 14 oz. can corn, drained
1 4-7 oz. can diced green chilies

1 14 oz. can diced tomatoes, with juice

1 14 oz. can chicken stock

1 Tbs. minced garlic

1 tsp. salt

Optional toppings: Chopped cilantro Tortilla strips Sour cream Shredded cheese Avocado

Add all of the soup ingredients to the slow cooker and stir to combine. Cook on high for 3-4 hours, or on low for 6-7 hours (or until chicken is cooked through). Use 2 forks to shred chicken. Serve hot with toppings if desired.
