Mark 14:8 (ESV) She has done what she could;

How would you like Jesus to say that about you? You did what you could. You didn't keep anything in reserve. You gave your all.

The account in Mark 14 is right before Jesus is to be betrayed, arrested and crucified. An unnamed woman (who is Mary according to John's gospel) enters the home of Simon the (former) leper where Jesus was dining. She breaks open a very expensive flask of ointment and poured it over Jesus head.

Those in attendance were indignant; they thought the perfume should have been sold instead of wasted. Jesus knew their thoughts and rebuked them. He told them she had anointed his body beforehand for burial. Her giving of the expensive perfume and her service was her act of worship. She did what she could.

In Mark 12, Jesus has his disciples watch those giving at the temple. Many rich people put in large sums, though it may not have even put a dent in their bank accounts. Then he points out the widow who put in two small copper coins. Jesus' math said the widow put in more than the others!

Mark 12:44 (ESV) "For they all contributed out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty has put in everything she had, all she had to live on."

For the kingdom of God to function properly on earth, believers need to be like these two women. Their service and worship was between them and God. It wasn't done for fame or recognition.

They did all they could.

Could Jesus say that about you? You did what you could? You put in everything?

This is personal. Only Jesus and you know your own heart, and sometimes you don't. One might look down upon your level of service or giving, but only the Lord knows all the mitigating circumstances that might prevent you from doing more. If you honestly do what you can, and the Holy Spirit confirms that within your spirit, keep up your good work!

The Lord also knows when you are holding back, putting too much time into worldly endeavors, or giving a lukewarm effort. Remember the words of scripture: *Philippians 2:12-13 (ESV)* Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.

The purpose of this is not to shame anyone into serving. It needs to be from the heart. The purpose is to inspire self-examination and to provide opportunity.

Here are two areas where opportunities exist (and they are not exhaustive):

Church: Look at the ministry folders on the table in the foyer. Yes, the ones that have been there for over a month now. Those folders. Each folder is an opportunity to do what you can. It would be wonderful if someone with some computer skills could take over some of the technology in church. There are almost always some kind of maintenance to do and Jay and Kevin would welcome help. Summer is right around the corner. Who wants to mow or help keep the grounds looking good?

Camp: Our camp is at a crossroads. The situation with the city of Horton still hangs over our head like a cloud. Camp is proceeding just like any other year, but even if the city drops the issue, camp still needs help. We need a maintenance person on site during camp weeks. Right now there are three weeks in June that need help. Camp has maintenance needs before it even begins. Camp needs volunteers for counselors, dorm parents, etc. to work with the deans during their weeks. Camp also needs campers. Without more volunteers and campers, camp will not survive.

TIME CHANGE: Time change will be Mar. 11th. Don't forget to set your clocks ahead one hour.


Men's Breakfast: The men's breakfast will be on Mar. 10th at 8:00 AM. Mike Kirby is cooking.
