Labor Day

Labor Day is the unofficial end of the summer. For many it is a day off from work they look forward to. It's time for football to begin. It is an occasion for family get-togethers, cookouts and picnics. And a time for a LOCK-IN!

That's right! And you know what lock-ins require? Labor. Work. Up all night. With teens.

There are many ways your labor can be used as we pull off this event for our students. You can actually be here and help supervise. You can provide snacks or meals. You can help set up or clean up. You can donate items or money to help provide food. Many of you have already signed up to help. Thank you!! It is all labor for the Lord.

God doesn't NEED anything, but he desires you to work for Him. We are called to "work out our own salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure." Here are several things the Bible teaches us about our labor for the Lord.

1. Our labor doesn't save us.

Ephesians 2:8-9 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

2. God still requires us to work.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

- **2 Corinthians 9:8** And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work.
- 3. God will equip us for our labor. **Colossians 1:28-29 (NIV)** We proclaim him, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone perfect in Christ. To this end I labor, struggling with all <u>His energy</u>, which so <u>powerfully works in me</u>.

Ephesians 4:11-12 And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ.

4. God will reward us for our labor.

1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.

Ephesians 6:7-8 (NIV) Serve wholeheartedly, as if you were serving the Lord, not men, because you know that the Lord will reward everyone for whatever good he does, whether he is slave or free.

Hebrews 6:10 (ESV) For God is not unjust so as to overlook your work and the love that you have shown for his name in serving the saints, as you still do.

5. Refusing to work is not an option. James 2:14,17 What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that faith save him? So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.

James 4:17 So whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, for him it is sin.

And we all know the parable of the talents, where the wicked servant who refused to put the Master's talent to work was thrown outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Jesus tells us in Matthew 9:37-38, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." We are the workers Jesus is talking about. He is calling us to go and make disciples, baptize them and teach them to obey Jesus' commands. He didn't say wait for a church program. He didn't say wait for permission from a church board or elders. He said go. So let's make every day a labor day and get to work for the Lord!


