A recent message left on the church answering machine: *Hi, this is Megan, I'm reaching out to you today because Amazon currently has customers looking for your services in your area.*

If you are interested in receiving customers from the Amazon/Alexa network, please give me a call at 888-xxx-xxxx

We are only taking a select few in your area so be sure to contact us quickly. There is no charge to see if you qualify, so please give us a call at 888-xxx-xxxx

You can start receiving these inquiries immediately. Thank you.

Really? Does Amazon know this is a church? If there are people who are really looking for a church in this area, it wouldn't be that hard to find one.

The message made me think. Do we (the church) see potential members as customers? Do church members see themselves as consumers? In fact, people casually throw out the line, "We're church shopping," when looking for somewhere to worship.

If church members see themselves as consumers, that poses a problem. Consumers usually are focused on what they can GET. They normally want to GET the most value for the least amount of output.

You will hear church consumers say things like, "I didn't get anything out of the sermon today." "I don't like the worship there." "Well, the parking isn't very convenient." "They don't have enough kids." "I'm just not being fed."

That makes it sound like the music is more like a radio. If you don't like it, find another station. The sermon is a commodity. If I don't like the flavor of what they are feeding me, find another restaurant.

The problem with consumer Christians is they almost always GET but they rarely GIVE. Instead of complaining about what you don't GET at church, pray about how you can GIVE at church. Not simply offerings, no! How can you help to make sure someone else is fed? Perhaps you can use your gifts to help out with the song service. Do you have ideas that will help make the building more welcoming? If your children are at church, then perhaps that will encourage another family to bring their children.

There are many reasons someone will feel like they aren't being fed. Maybe you have been on a solid diet of spiritual junk food and the real meat of the gospel 'tastes funny' to you. Maybe someone else needs to hear the message that doesn't meet your need, but your presence is still necessary for their encouragement. Perhaps you just don't like the truth about your sin.


Another problem with church consumers is that what the Lord, and by association, his church offers isn't something that can be purchased.

You can't buy the friendships that are built when you selflessly immerse yourself into the body of Christ. You can't buy peace or joy or salvation.

Those things have already been purchased once and for all by the precious blood of Christ.

On the flip side, what if the church started acting like everyone else was a customer? What if we went overboard to make sure everyone felt welcomed? What if we tried to fix the things that might keep a 'customer' from returning? [Without, of course, watering down the truth of God's word.]

I don't think Amazon can sell what the Christ has to offer. But it wouldn't hurt the church to reach out and find those who need it. Megan from Amazon says there are people in our area who have need of what we have to offer. Of that, I am sure she is right!


Men's Breakfast: The men's breakfast will be Saturday, September 14th at 8:00 AM. Mike Kirby is cooking.
