Once walls and doors are constructed, fresh paint will give these rooms an updated look. Finally, old carpet will be torn up to be replaced with laminate flooring (a padded vinyl type floor in the nursery).

The hope here is that families with children will understand we value them. They will see clean, safe, updated spaces for their kids. Hopefully they will understand that, more importantly, we teach the word of God that is clean and safe as well.

It is important that this doesn't remain the best kept secret in town. As we prepare nice areas for children, our family needs to inform new and visiting families these nice areas exist!

I believe the transformed product will look great! It is the waiting in the midst of dirt and chaos that is hard.

This reminds me a bit of the transformation that takes place in our lives when we come to Jesus. **2** Corinthians **5:17 (ESV)** Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed

away, behold, the new has come.

The new has come...inwardly. We are looked upon by God and he sees the righteousness of Christ. He has given and forgiven. He has given us a new nature and forgiven us of our sin. This is justification. Importantly, God does NOT want us to stop there!!

Though we are forgiven, the desire to sin usually doesn't immediately disappear. Life is chaotic as our new nature struggles with the 'old self.' There is some demolition that must occur in our lives. Dirty language. Filthy habits. Walls of separation between ourselves and others need to be torn down and replaced with a fresh coat of Jesus.

This process is sanctification. It is the act of becoming more like Jesus over time as we follow him. It is a messy process as we struggle to live daily through the demo and new construction going on in our spirit.

As we all go through this process – and it is a life-long process – keep in mind how good it will be when God is finished with us.

1 John 3:2-3 (ESV) Beloved, we are God's children now, and what we will be has not yet appeared; but we know that when he appears we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he is. And everyone who thus hopes in him purifies himself as he is pure.

The construction is complete when we are done with this life and in the presence of Jesus. One day, we will be like Jesus – inside and out – with new glorified bodies.

Until then, keep hammering away at the sinful nature and through the power of the Holy Spirit in you, become more and more like Jesus.
