This month we are going to look at scriptures that direct us to think properly. In other words, we want our thought life and the things we meditate on to be pleasing to God so we can live in a way that brings him glory.

God wants us to think reasonably and logically with the minds he gave us. We must also understand that some of God's ways are above our understanding. So we need wisdom to discern what we must accept by faith.

Let me encourage to go back over the scriptures from last month that were for memory. The Bible is the greatest wisdom and are the words God has given us. Having God's word in our hearts will help us to direct our thoughts toward the things that please Christ.

There are some other words to look for in these readings. When we see 'heart' in the Bible, it can often refer to our mind. When the psalmist wrote, "I have stored up your word in my heart that I might not sin against God," he was talking about scriptures he had committed to memory so his thinking would be in line with the Father. Other words to look for are understanding, wisdom, and mind.

Some verses will highlight right, godly thoughts. Others may point out faulty or foolish thoughts. Jesus asked the scribes, "Why do you think evil in your hearts?" Jesus said, "Our words flow from the content of our hearts." He means the things we think about will eventually come out in our conversations.

Remember, Psalm 119:11, I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you. When we fill our minds with the ungodly, we will then think about ungodly things; those thoughts are sinful. Jesus said in the Sermon on the Mount, Matthew 5:28 But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lustful intent has already committed adultery with her in his heart. He entertained sinful thoughts.

Sinful thoughts will eventually lead to sinful actions. 1 Corinthians 14:20 tells us, "Do not be children in your thinking. Be infants in evil, but in

your thinking be mature." What better way to be mature Christians and be like Jesus than to be filled with Scripture?

Read the daily selection. Read the verses around it to get more context. Pray about them and ask God to let your heart and mind always be fixed on Jesus.


