Galatians 6:2 (ESV) Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

I've preached that before. If you don't let someone know you have a need, you can't expect them to meet that need. If people don't know you have a burden, they can't help bear it.

Now I have lived it.

It is not always easy for the preacher to live out what he is preaching. There is a certain selfimposed requirement to have it all together. How in the world can the preacher help with your messes when he is a mess??

There is also an element of pride involved for the preacher to be able to appear to have all the answers and always be calm, while underneath the surface things are unsure and chaotic.

I have been preaching at VFCC weekly since September of 2003. I was called as the full time minister in December of the same year. During that time, I have preached approximately 800 sermons. I have never missed a Sunday that wasn't scheduled for any reason, including sickness – until February 23, 2020.

That's not to say I haven't been sick. I either rallied to feel better by Sunday or battled through it. Not this time.

I felt great preaching on the 16th. I was relaxing for a couple of hours at home after church before heading to the Preaching and Teaching Convention at OCC when I began to get a tickle in my throat. By the time I got to Kansas City, I had to stop and pick up cough drops.

By Tuesday afternoon, I felt poorly enough I decided to discontinue the conference and headed home the next morning. A Thursday doctor's appointment brought the diagnosis of Influenza A.

I asked the doctor when I could be around other people again with the intent of being able to set up for the funeral service on Saturday and preach on Sunday. I wasn't even going to ask for help!

How can someone help with a burden unless one makes the burden known?

I am so blessed to serve at VFCC. [I'll leave out the names; these folks didn't serve for recognition, but because they love the Lord.]

I received a call to find out how I was doing. I hadn't even told anyone I was that sick except those I absolutely had to (pride again?).

I was told not to worry about Saturday, it would be taken care of. So much work went into preparing the church for a service that approximately 240 attended! And I thought I could do this on my own!!

I was later told (lovingly) to stay home on Sunday morning. People filled in where they were needed. The church worshiped. You were preached a message from the scripture. God was glorified – and He didn't need me there to do it! God's people came together to do what God's people do! Bear one another's burdens.

I didn't get back into the office until Wednesday – and still wasn't 100%. So I have to say thank you to everyone who came together to be the church. Not MY church, but the Lord's church that we are all a part of.

I have to thank God for an illness that taught me humility. An illness through which God told me it is OK to let go and trust him, and taught me how much a church can care for her pastor.

No one is called to it all alone. That's why Jesus built the church. It's why he gave us each other. It's why he has to teach hard-headed pastors lessons every once in a while. It's why he called us to bear one another's burdens!
