I am the vine; you are the branches...John 15:5

We still recite it in the old King James. Thy name. Thy kingdom. Thy will. Hallowed and trespasses are words we rarely use today for holy and sin.

It is the Lord's Prayer. Some churches recite this prayer every Sunday. Often it is incorporated in funeral services. There are many unchurched (though probably older) people who can recite this prayer from memory. Many who can recite it don't realize they are quoting scripture when they do.

Many likely do not pay attention to the significance of the words they are saying. When we pray this prayer, we ask God for daily sustenance. We declare the Lord is holy and worthy of glory. We acknowledge the Lord's forgiveness for us is based upon how we forgive others. We agree that we want the Lord to keep us from temptation and deliver us from the evil one.

Jesus often went to be alone and pray. The disciples witnessed this, and after Jesus came back once, they asked him to teach them to pray like John taught his disciples to pray (in Luke 11). This is important! They asked Jesus, "Teach us to pray." Not, "Teach us a prayer."

In all likelihood, this was meant to be a template for prayer, not something repeated by rote. It also could be more accurately called The Disciple's Prayer, since it was for them.

During March, read, meditate on, and pray over the following verses that teach about the elements of the Lord's Prayer. If you have extra time, read the context and look up related references.

Each morning during prayer, pray about these elements as you ask God's direction for your day.


Men's Breakfast: The men's breakfast will be Saturday, March 12th at 8:00 AM. Charlie Brown is cooking.
