I encourage you again this month to make reading through the Psalms and Proverbs part of your daily routine. Reading a chapter a day through June, and repeat in the second half of the year.

While there are many wonderful Psalms, most of the ones chosen for this month have something to do with giving thanks.

The Psalms are the hymns of ancient Judaism. At the Last Supper, Jesus gave thanks for the bread before saying, "This is my body." He gave thanks for the wine, saying, "This is my blood." He then gave instructions that we were to observe this memorial until he returned.

After the Last Supper, Mark and Matthew tell us they sang a hymn before going to the Mount of Olives. I wonder if Jesus chose a hymn of Thanksgiving, Psalm 136 perhaps, after establishing the Lord's Supper.

Paul, a former Pharisee that Jesus converted, was well schooled in the Old Testament Scriptures. When you read his letters, you see that he gives thanks, and commands thanksgiving often. Most of his letters have some sort of message of thanksgiving for the recipients in the first section. (Rom 1:8; 1 Cor 1:4; Eph 1:15; etc.)

I can imagine his deep sense of gratitude, that God would actually choose to save him who had previously persecuted the church and call him to evangelize the gentiles, would let him see the Psalms of thanksgiving in a new light.

We get these gems from Paul's writings – under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit:

1 Corinthians 15:57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 2:14 But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere.

Colossians 3:15-16 And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms

and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

Read the following verses in context, reading the entire chapter if you have time. See if there is a certain verse you might commit to memory. Remember, His word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.
