Fall is here. The daylight hours grow shorter while darkness invades our nights.

We live in a world of spiritual darkness as well. The Bible depicts evil as darkness. God is light. Darkness stands for sin, the works of the devil and anything opposed to God. Light stands for goodness, purity and all things that flow from God.

This time of year there is a greater focus on darkness because of Halloween. Slasher and horror movies often premier on or around October 31. Many costumes focus on violent, gruesome and scary images. The occult receives more attention.

Perhaps in your family Halloween is simply a time of dress-up, fun, and eating a lot of candy. You may even forego the scary aspect and focus on fall and harvest themes. One still cannot deny that a dark cloud surrounds aspects of the holiday. (I struggle calling it a holiday, because holiday derives from "holy day." While Halloween seems harmless and fun for a lot of people, I can find nothing holy about it.)

How you decide to recognize the day is between you and the Lord. I would remind everyone that as Christians we are not to be like the world. Romans 12:2 (ESV) Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

My challenge is for everyone regardless of how you see the day. Every day through the month of October, read the appointed scripture references about good and evil, light and dark, purity and defilement. Pray about them. Read surrounding verses to get a better context. Follow related references your study Bible may give you. Pray that we can all be people of light.
